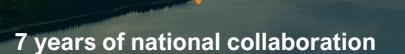

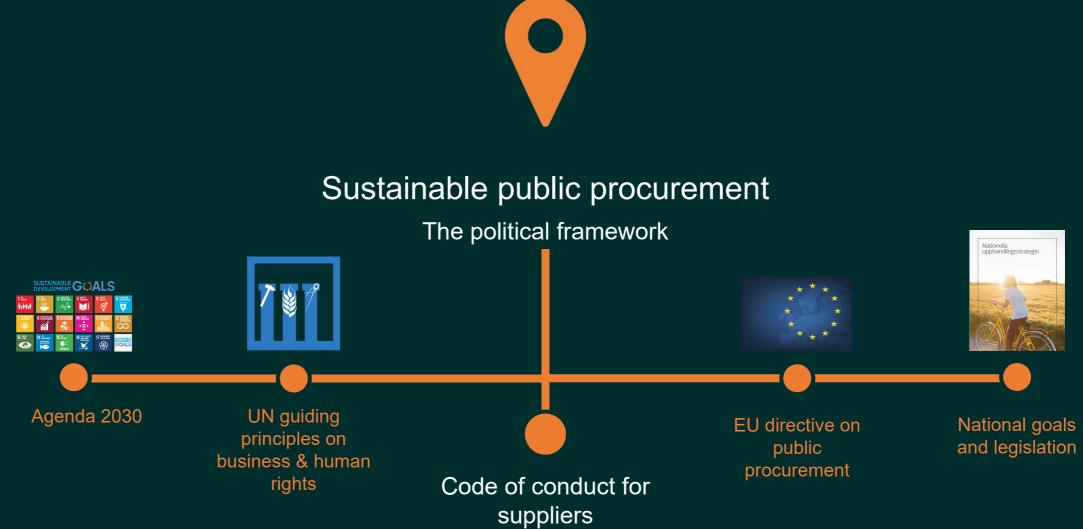

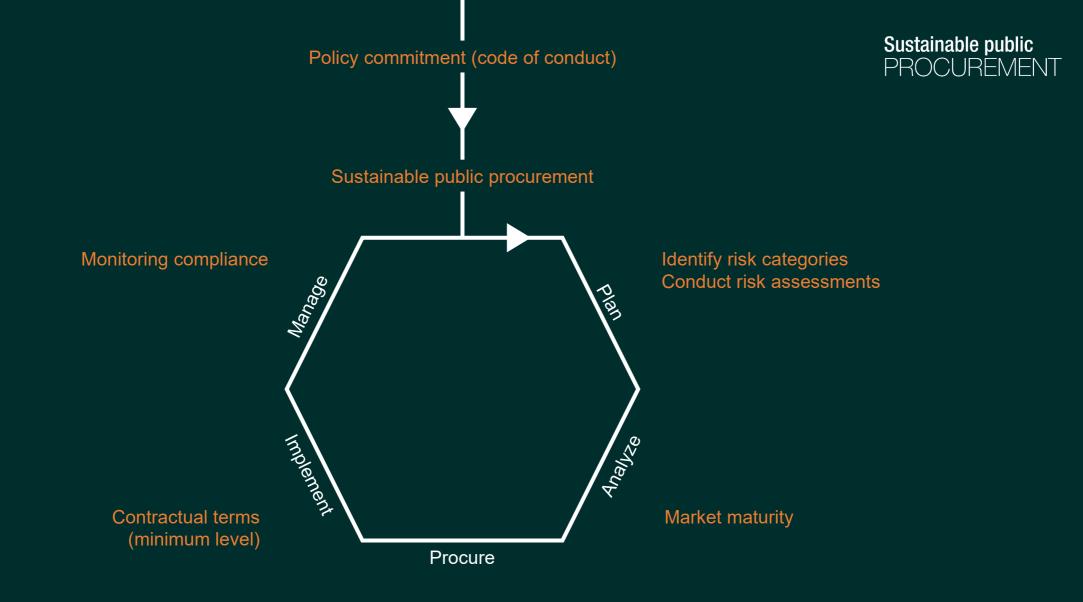

Requirements on suppliers



The measures shall be taken in accordance with the **UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights**, or the equivalent.









The self-assessment

A follow up starts with the supplier answering a self-assessment.

In the self-assessment, the supplier is asked to describe its policy commitment, division of responsibility, as well as its procedures for identifying and managing risks.

The supplier is also asked to present its due diligence for specific products that they deliver to the regions.





The desktop audit

An auditor goes to the supplier's office to monitor compliance against the contract terms.

Through dialogue and document reviews, the auditor verifies the answers in the self-assessment and ensures that the procedures described are integrated into daily operations.

The desktop audit serves to ensure that the supplier is actively identifying and managing risks in the supply chain.





The factory audit

An auditor goes to a factory, either the supplier's own factory or a subcontractor's, to verify compliance with the fundamental terms.

The audit is also a way to ensure that the procedures are effective in practice.

Prior the audit, a risk analysis must be conducted so that the audit can focus on the most severe risks.

During the factory, a team of auditors goes to the factory to speak to management, interview workers as well as inspect the factory and dormitories.

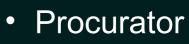

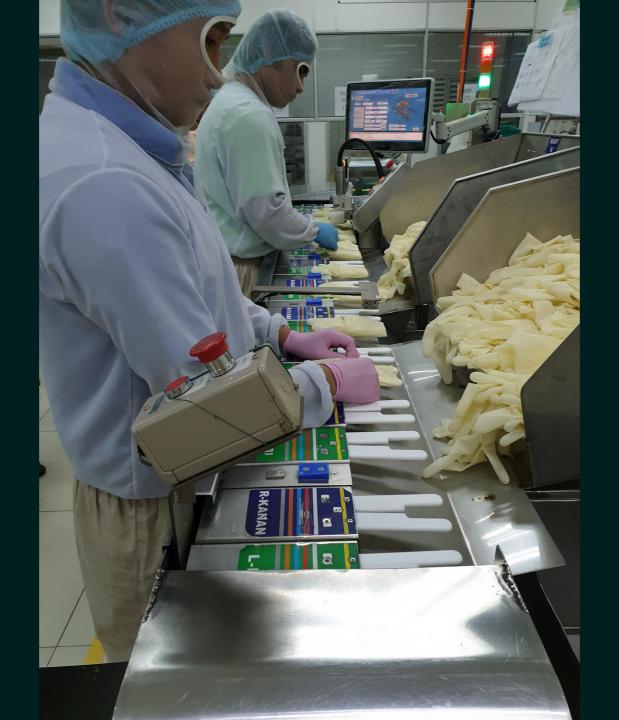

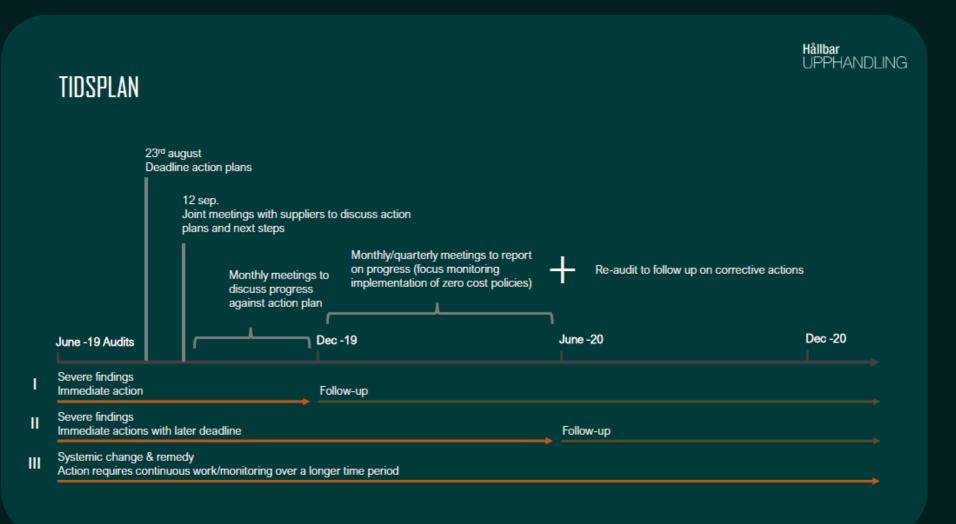

Joint meetings to encourage collaboration within the industry!



Main challenges

- Low risk awareness among suppliers to swedish regions (contracting parties)
- Long supply chains (agents or parent companies between supplier and Malaysian manufacturer slowing the process down)
- Low levels of influence prices of gloves are too low!
- Commitment to repay recruitment fees in general low; requires stakeholder engagement!
- Factories facing audit fatigue, difficult to answer to different types of requirements?
